

## Registered used fumigants in India against stored grain pests

- Aluminium phosphide (56% tablet, pellet & sachets formulations, 15% & 6% tablet and 77.7% GR)
- Methyl Bromide\*
- Ethylene Dichloride Carbon Tetrachloride# (3:1)

\*Methyl bromide has been designated as an ozone-depleting substance in the Montreal Protocol (1987) and was to be eventually phased out globally by 2015 but has critical use exemption still usable in Quarantine and Pre-shipment.

#Carbon tetrachloride has been identified as an ozone depleting substance and banned for non-feedstock applications under the Montreal Protocol but it continues to be useable under the protocol as a chemical feedstock and for specific, approved laboratory uses.
